Landscape Update

August action item list

- + Apply Fertilizer, weed control, & deadhead flowers
- + Turf mowing & edging
- + Control weeds in turf as needed
- + Curb & bed edging
- + Remove suckering growth from trees
- + Prune new shoot growth from shrubs as needed
- + Test soil for proper nutrient & pH levels; adjust turf program as needed
- + Inspect trees & shrubs for active insects & diseases & treat as necessary
- + Check turf for disease & propose fungicide application as needed
- + If present, propose Bermuda grass control within fescue turf in preparation for fall seeding

September action item list

- + Turf mowing, edging, and trimming
- + Control emerging weeds in turf
- + If necessary, propose lime application as outlined from soil test results
- + Bed edging and trimming
- + As needed apply fertilizer to declining trees and shrubs
- + Inspect trees and shrubs for insect and disease activity and control
- + Aerate, over-seed, and fertilize Fescue turf
- + Apply Fertilizer, weed control, and deadhead flowers
- + Apply fertilizer and pre-emergent to warm season turf
- + Prepare fall season color designs for customer approval




Landscape Update
